Alleluia (Choir)

Gospel (Priest proclaims the gospel)

Short reflection \*seated

Song of mediation (Lead by Choir)

Rosary (one decade) \*seated

Our Father....

Presider: I am the bread which has come from heaven

**All: Anyone who eats this bread will live forever** (John 6:51)

Hail Mary....

Presider: I tell you most solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood

**All: you shall not have life in you** (John 6:53)

Hail Mary....

Presider: For my flesh is real food and my blood real drink

**All: He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood lives in Me and I live in them** (John 6:55)

Hail Mary....

Presider: After this many of His disciples stopped going to Him.

**All: Then Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you want to go away too?"** (John 6:67)

Hail Mary....

Presider: Simon Peter answered, "Lord, to whom shall we go to?"

**All: "You have the message of eternal life."** (John 6:68)

Hail Mary....

Presider: And we believe

**All: We know that you are the Holy One of God.** (John 6:69)

Hail Mary....

Presider: Now on the night He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread

**All: And when He had said the blessing, He broke it.** (Matthew 26:26)

Hail Mary....

Presider: And He gave it to His disciples saying, "Take and eat"

**All: "This is My body"** (Matthew 26:26)

Hail Mary....

Presider: Then He took the chalice, when He had given thanks, He gave it to them.

**All: "Drink all of you from this," He said** (Matthew 26:27)

Hail Mary....

Presider "For this is My blood, the blood of the new covenant."

**All: "which is to be poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."** (Matthew 26:28)

Hail Mary....

Presider: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**All: As it was in the beginning, now and shall be forever. Amen.**

"Tantum Ergo Sacramentum" (Breaking Bread #26)

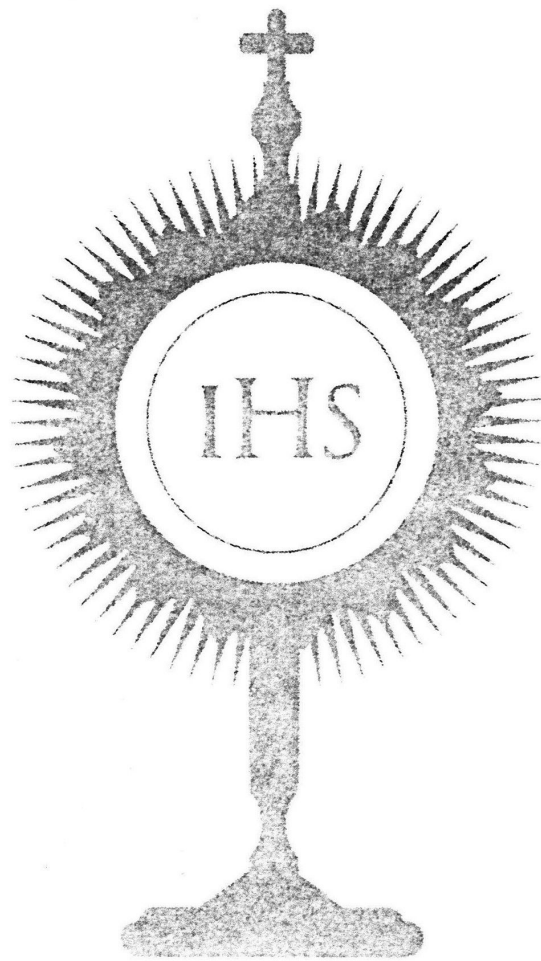
Prayer (Inside, back cover of Breaking Bread)
