Mandate Changes to Mass Next Weekend

Pray For Supreme Court Decision

It is for this reason that Bishop Larry has asked each parish to conduct Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the evening of Saturday, November 27 through the morning of Sunday, November 28 to pray for the justices of the Supreme Court to be guided by the Holy Spirit in this decision.

We will begin adoration after the Saturday evening Mass and end just prior to the 6:30 AM Mass. Please consider spending an hour in prayer before our Lord for this very important life issue.
