Lush, healthy grass allows for a wonderful option for the children to spend recess and even outdoor class opportunities.

The sprinkler project has been a project we've wanted to complete for the last 2 years. Thanks to the huge success of the Fall Regal Fundraiser, we were able to proceed with this dream! We earned \$3,569 over the goal and used \$1,229 for the materials needed for the irrigation. The two weekends of labor cost \$0 thanks to the generous time and talent of Mr. John Abitria (Brad 4 & Alona 2) and the help of Mr. Jovic Luarca (Amelia PS3)!

"Put out into the deep water and lower your nets for a great catch." – Luke 5:4

Today we hear about the great catch. Jesus' invitation was accepted and followed by the apostles, which led them to the great catch of apostleship.

Our encounter with Jesus always has a deeper meaning and purpose. Jesus, after addressing the vast crowd, slowly moved toward the fishermen and sat in Simon Peter's boat. He continued to teach the crowd. Jesus interacted with the fishermen in a very personal and intimate way that led them to realize who they were. "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Jesus did not depart from them but rather came closer and invited them to be with Him and chose them to be His ambassadors for the Father's Kingdom. CONFIRMATION & FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: Please contact the Parish Office for more details.

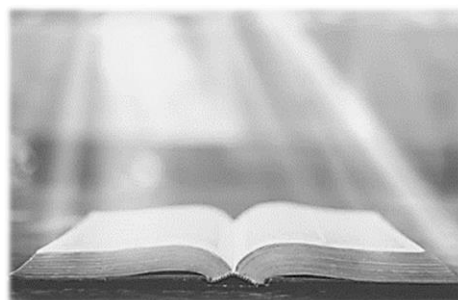
