From the Pastor's Desk

Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord. – John 6:56

Jesus continues to invite us to recognize what He is offering to us, that is, His own very flesh. The very purpose of His offering is to make us partakers of eternal life, the very nature of God. We need to understand it not in human terms but in divine terms. We can then recognize how blessed we are to have God love us in this manner, to the extent that God is willing to give His very flesh to us.

It is not about us but about God. It is not our actions but God's loving action. The only desire and purpose for Jesus is to bring us home, that is, heaven, the dwelling of God eternally. What Adam and Eve lost in disobedience, Jesus redeems in obedience through dying on the cross, giving His very flesh and blood in His one sacrifice that cleanses all sins away and defeats the powers of Satan. When we consume Jesus in the Eucharist, we become beneficiaries of that one supreme sacrifice of salvation and worthy of eternal life.

May the Holy Spirit empower and enlighten us to accept Jesus in His flesh and blood in the Holy Eucharist, not as a symbol, but as the real flesh and blood of Jesus the Lord. Jesus is present in the Eucharist in His totality: body, blood, soul, and divinity. God said, and it is what it is, His Body and Blood.

May Our Lady of Good Counsel intercede for us.
