*From the Pastor's Desk*

**"God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, and entrusting to us the message of salvation."  
2 Corinthians 5:19**

Today's readings invite us to the deep reality of prayer: that God is invested in our prayers. He loves us and so pays attention to our prayers and answers them. We hear in the first reading that God listens to our prayer. We are reminded of the importance of serving the Lord at all times.

In the Gospel, we are reminded to have a humble, sincere heart in prayer. We are not to be self-righteous, proud, or haughty, like the Pharisee in prayer, but rather be sincere in admitting our sins and unworthiness and seek God's mercy and grace. We are to be just like the tax collector who came to the temple with sincere sorrow for his sins, ashamed of his wrongdoings. He feels unworthy to stand before God, but relying on the mercy of God, he pleads for God's mercy.

May this guide us to grow in our own prayer lives, remaining humble and avoiding the urge to demand or dictate what God should do for our loved ones or us. We are to trust in the Lord's saving grace.

May the Holy Spirit enlighten and empower us.

May Our Lady of Good Counsel intercede for us.
