From the Pastor's Desk

***"Come, you who are blessed by my Father;
inherit the kingdom prepared for you from
the foundation of the world." Matthew 25: 34***

The loss of a loved one brings with it sorrow due to a deeply felt absence in our daily life. We mourn the separation, even when it was not unexpected. But the pain of our loss is tempered and eased by our hope and trust in the Lord, in his mercy, and in his promise to grant eternal life to those who believe in him. We cooperate with him by praying for those who have died and asking the Lord to bring them swiftly to himself.

The first reading reflects on the blessed fate of the *souls of the just* who, after death, *are in the hand of God*. Paul rejoices in the love of God evidenced in Christ's sacrifice for us, which he undertook while we were still sinners. In the Gospel Jesus tells the crowd, *I will not reject anyone who comes to me*. He says the will of the Father is that all who see and believe in his Son have eternal life.
