From the Pastor's Desk

**“Glory to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit;
to God who is, who was, and who is to come.”
Revelation 1:8**

In today's readings, we are encouraged to contemplate with wonder and awe the beauty of God. The Church invites us to explore humbly the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity and to grapple with the truths of this fundamental insight into the essence of God's being. The three Persons of the Holy Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – are one, but are distinct from each other. Thus, we can say they are in relationship with one another – an eternal communion of love. Confronted with this mystery, let us contemplate with wonder and awe the beauty of God.

In the first reading, the wisdom of God speaks of being present when the Lord established the heavens, *beside him as his craftsman*. In the Epistle, Paul writes *we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ*, and that the Holy Spirit has been given to us. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that the Spirit of truth will guide *them to all truth*, declaring to them everything that is his.
